LEVEL ONE - Creation Lesson #6 - Dry Land/Soil/Rock

Aim/Goal:	To show the children that God created the Earth (including the soil and the rocks)
Bible Verse:	Genesis 1:10a "And God called the dry land Earth,"
Bible Reference:	Genesis 1:9-10 "And God said, Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear; and it was so. And God called the dry land Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas; and God saw that it was good."
Story Suggestion:	 Do a quick review of the lessons presented so far. Show pictures of land such as mountains and the ocean next to it. Ask the children about going to the beach - sand and water are separate. Bring in a sample of soil like potting soil and rocks of different shapes and colors. Ask children to touch a rock. Kids at this age are fascinated by the surface and colors of different rocks.
Craft /Activity Suggestion:	 Use a blank sheet of paper. Draw mountains or volcanoes and an ocean on the bottom to show that they are separate. Depending on the ability of the kids, they can color or paste. Glue the verse at the bottom. Use blue construction paper to cut out water, and brown or tan construction paper to cut out land. The children can paste on "flowers" or plants" using crinkled, colored, wrapping tissue.
